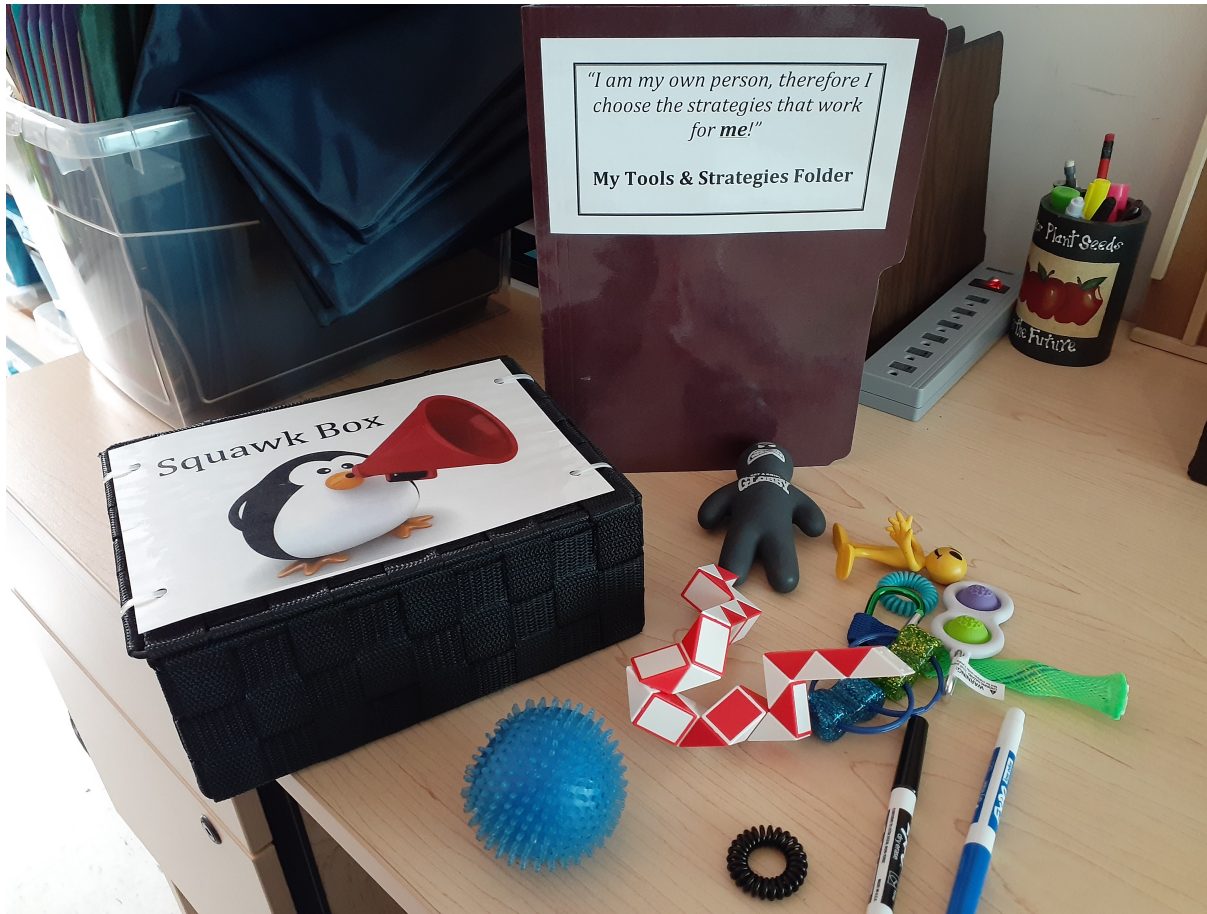

Inside the Squawk Box and the accompanying folder



Part A: Preparing the Squawk Box container



You will need the following materials:

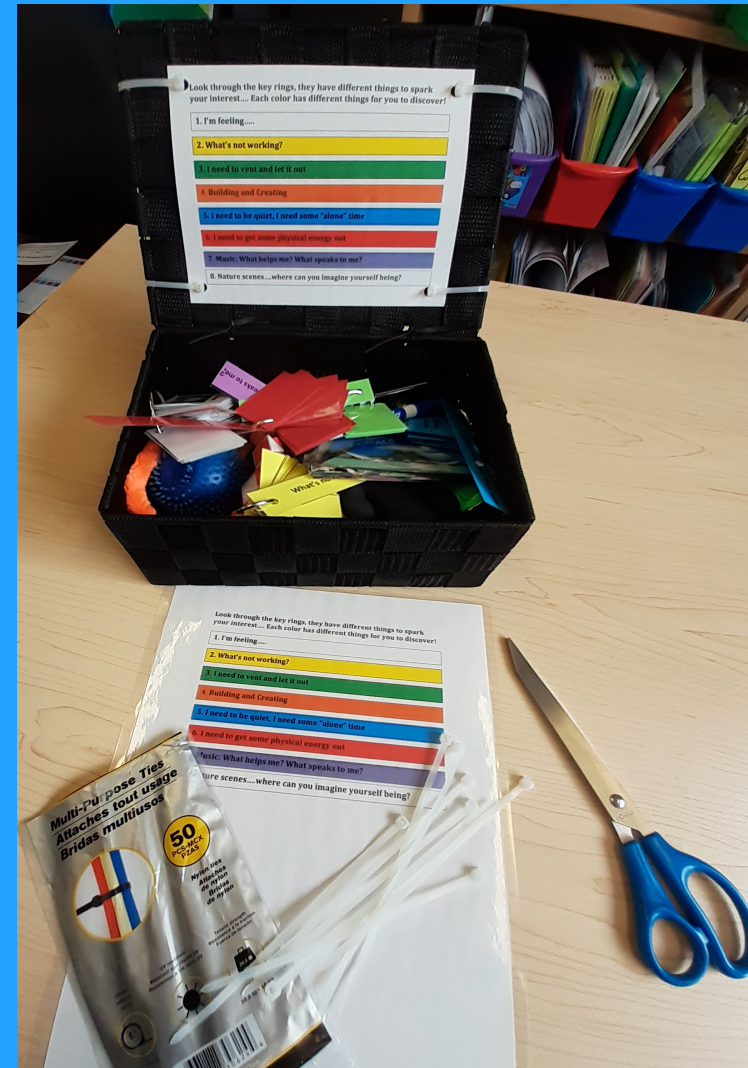
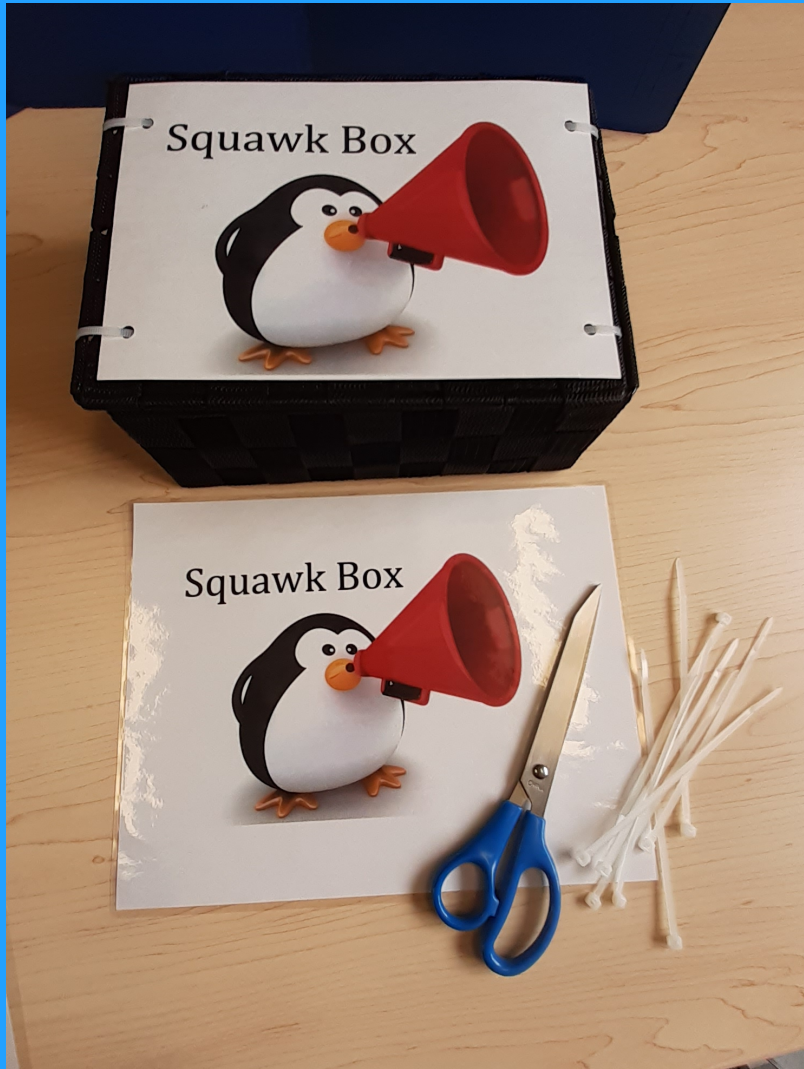
- ☐ Empty box with lid attached to it (18 cm Wide x 24 cm Long x 13 cm High)
- ☐ Documents for cover and inside cover (color printing is required)
- ☐ Lamination sheets
- ☐ Tie-wraps
- ☐ Scissors/cutting board
- ☐ Single hole punch

Part A: Preparing the Squawk Box container

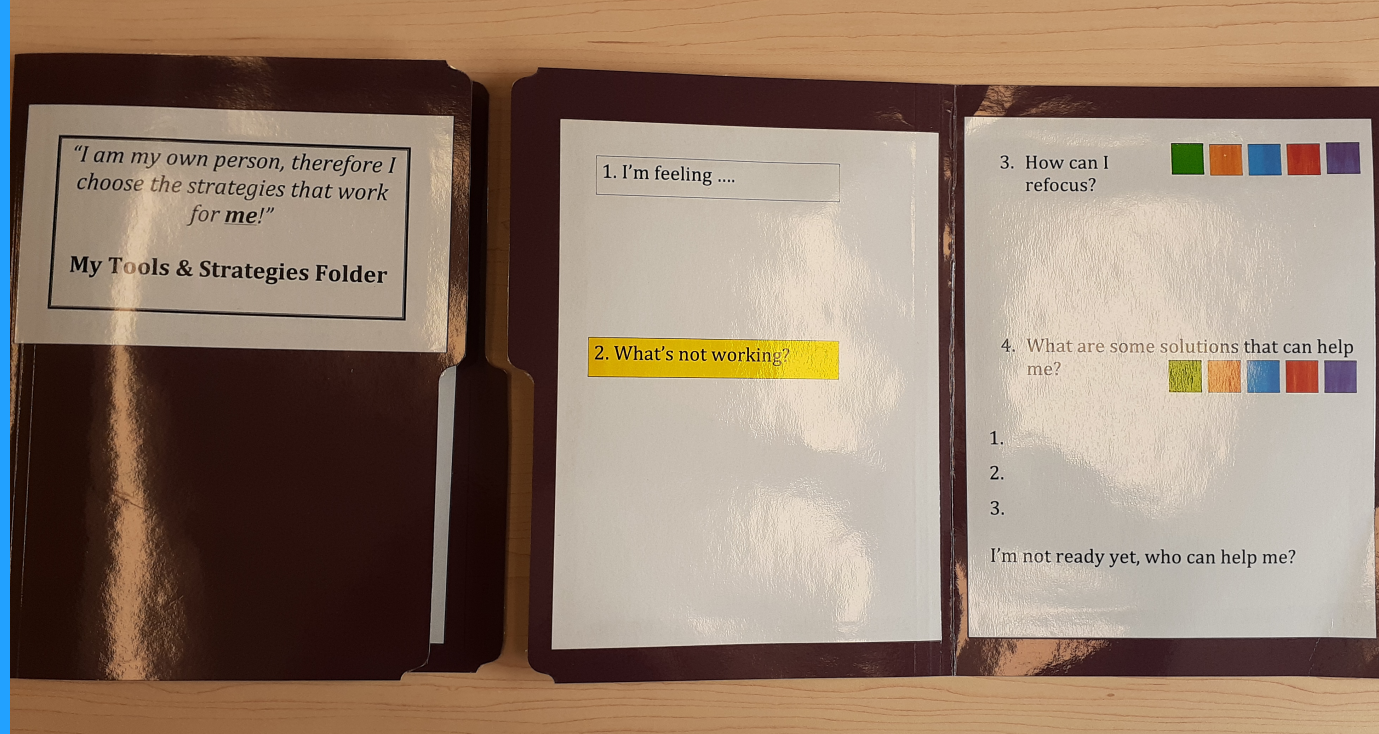
- Color Print the document for the cover and inside of the cover of the container
- Laminate the two documents
- Cut each of them to fit the size of the lid to your Squawk Box
- Using hole punch, make holes in each corner



Part A: Preparing the Squawk Box container



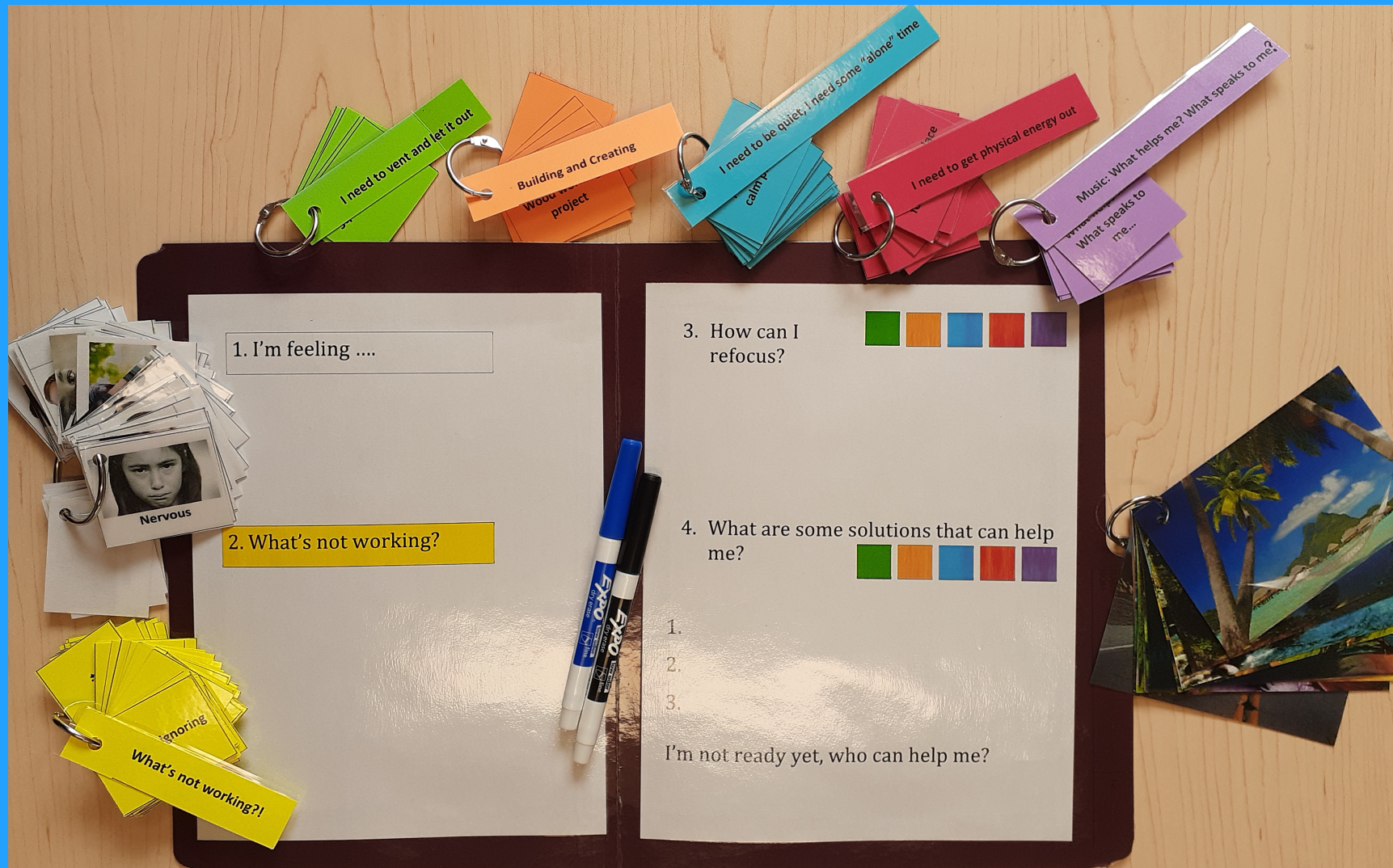
Part B: Preparing the folder



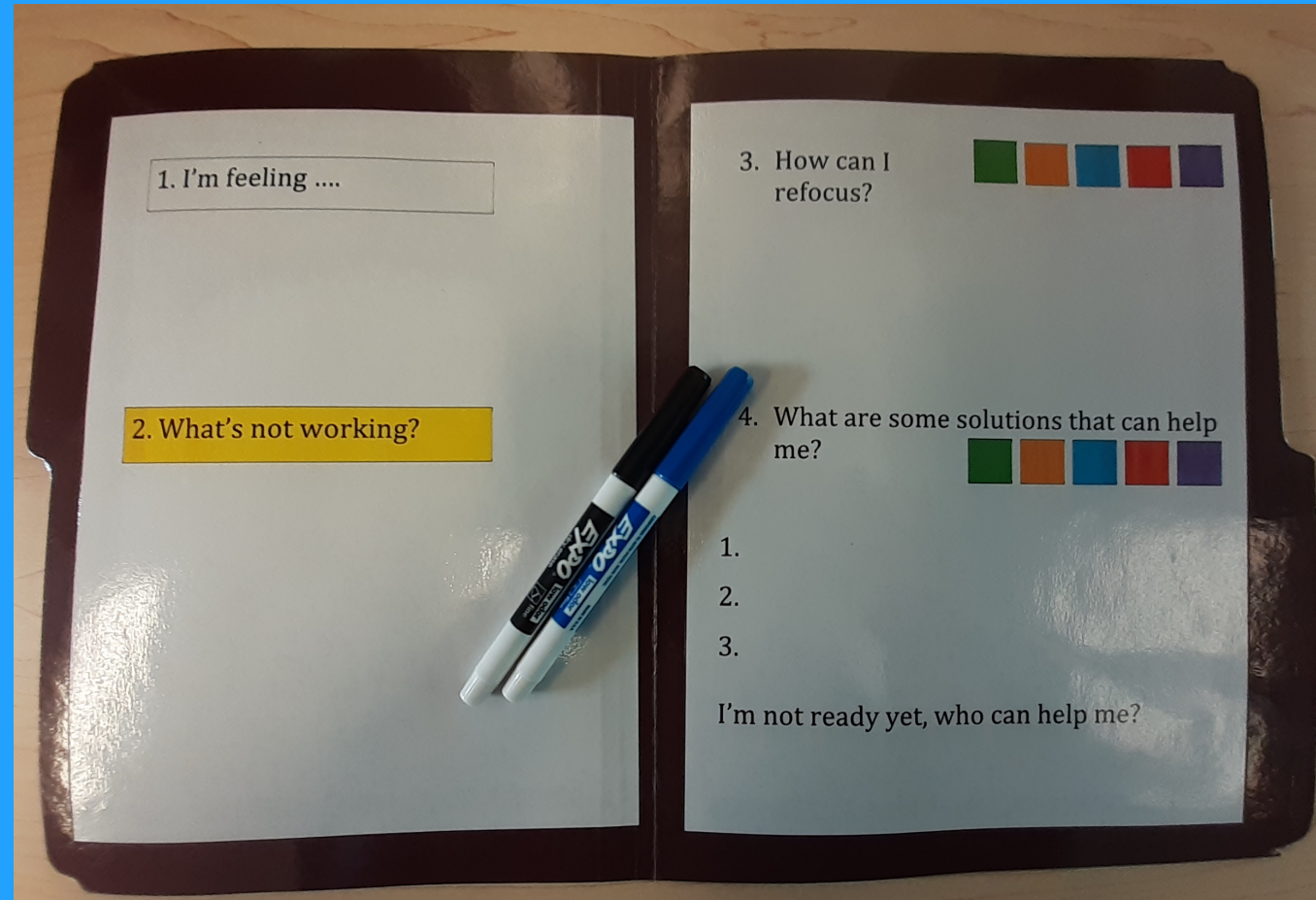
You will need the following materials:

- 1 letter size folder
- Color printed document entitled "Cycle 2-3 Emotions Folder"
- Glue stick or double sided tape
- Wide laminate machine
- Scissors and cutting board
- 2 dry-erase markers

Color printing the folder inserts is *essential* in this intervention tool



Part B: Preparing the folder



Dry –erase markers will be used to write student responses during intervention

Part C: Preparing the intervention cards on key rings

You will need the following materials:

- ☐ Documents:
 - ☐ Emotion cards (color printing recommended)
 - ☐ Messages for cards on key rings
 - ☐ Nature scene photos (color printing recommended)
- ☐ 6 – 1 inch key rings
- ☐ 2- 1 ½ inch key rings
- ☐ Single hole punch
- ☐ Laminate sheets/laminator
- ☐ Scissors/cutting board



Color-coding the cards is *essential* in this intervention tool



Part D: Selecting fidget tools for your Squawk Box

Having items with different:

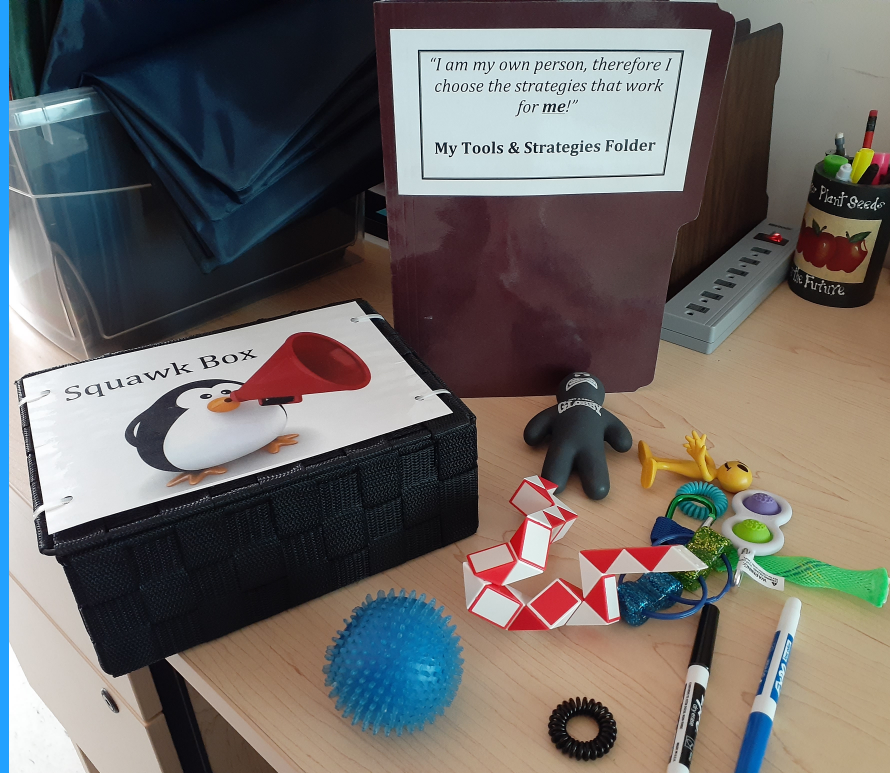
- ❑ Textures
- ❑ Colors
- ❑ Weights

Having items with different manipulative purposes:

- ☐ Squish
- ☐ Stretch
- ☐ Maneuver in different directions
- ☐ Hold single handedly
