Purpose of the IEP KIT

- Transforming the IEP into a living tool box, rather than just a document.
- Working as a team: student, parents, teachers, support staff, professionals in order to help the student achieve their goal(s).
- Quick access to materials
- Quality time spent with support staff.
- Track the frequency of resources and tools used.
- Monitoring the student's successes.
- Empowering the student to take ownership and be an advocate for themselves by becoming knowledgeable of the tools and adaptations available to them.

IEP Bookmark

• Visuals of the support measures and adaptations available to the student according to their IEP.

• The bookmark has groupings of pedagogical flexibility/best practices and adaptations, however it is not an exhaustive list.




Tracking Sheet

Goals from IEP

Why keep track?

- Three times a year we update the IEP. How are we supporting our students to achieve their goals?
- Support staff and other staff members can work on the goals with the student during daily 5, resource time, foster class, oasis room etc...
- We can see how the student is progressing, if they have achieved their goal(s). We need to re-evaluate the student goal(s) and the adaptations that are in place, if they are not showing progress.

What goes in the duo-tang?


- IEP Goals

• Materials and resources are put in the duo-tang that will help the student achieve their goals.

- Have support staff help create these kits with the resource teacher.
- The IEP kit is to stay in the school. On the IEP there is a list of suggestions on how the parents can support their child. Copies of materials can be made if requested.
